AN ACT to Authorize Sisters of Mercy of the Union in the United States of America, Province of Providence, Inc. to Receive, Take, Hold, Transmit and Convey Real and Personal Property to an Amount Not To Exceed Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000).

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Section 1. Sisters of Mercy of the Union in the United States of America, Province of Providence, Inc. a non-business charitable corporation, incorporated under the laws of the state of Rhode Island on May 7, 1931, for the purposes permitted for non-business corporations, is hereby authorized to receive, take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal property to an amount not to exceed twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000), and said real and personal estate shall be exempt from taxation so long as it shall be used for the purposes for which said corporation has been incorporated.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SISTERS OF MERCY OF THE UNION IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, PROVINCE OF PROVIDENCE, INC., TO HOLD PROPERTY TO AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING ONE MILLION DOLLARS.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Sisters of Mercy of the Union in the United States of America, Province of Providence, Inc., a corporation incorporated May 7, 1931, under the provisions of article III of chapter 248 of the general laws

of Rhode Island, 1923, is hereby authorized and empowered to take, hold, transmit, and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one million dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
