**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S FIRST & FINAL REPORT, APPROVING

This matter came to be heard on January 2, 2018, Justice Silverstein presiding, on the Receiver's Final Report, Request For Final Compensation And That He Be Discharged (hereinafter, the "Final Report") filed by the Receiver, Charles A. Pisaturo, Jr. on December 21, 2017. After considering the Final Report and all other related papers and pleadings in this matter, as well as the representations of the Receiver in open court, and for cause shown, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. The Receiver's Final Report is APPROVED;
2. That all of the Receiver's acts, doings and disbursements as Temporary and Permanent Receiver are hereby APPROVED, CONFIRMED and RATIFIED.
3. That the distribution of claims in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations in the Final Report is approved.
4. That the Receiver is allowed the amount of \$ 47,466.25 for final payment of his fees and \$ 2,621.54 for final reimbursement of his expenses.

That the receiver is authorized to pay his accountant Jeremiah Harrington \$ 1600.00 to complete any and all necessary tax returns and to pay his bookkeeper up to \$ 100.00 to complete the compilation of and accounting of receipts and disbursement records in order to complete the final tax returns.



After the Receiver pays the foregoing fees and expenses as approved, he is authorized and directed to pay any and all remaining funds to Fall River Five Cents Savings Bank, up to the unpaid balance of its allowed claim; and after making final payment of all remaining funds in his account as stated above, the Receiver shall be discharged and is allowed to cancel his bond.
