The portion of Section 1 of the charter of the
Bristol Home for Aged Women, which presently reads as
follows,

".... for the purpose of providing a Home for, and aid-
ing in the maintenance of aged American women in in-
digent circumstances, who shall have resided in the
Town of Bristol, at least five years."

is amended to read as follows:

".... for the purpose of providing a Home for, and/or
aiding in the maintenance of aged American men and
women in indigent circumstances who reside in the
Town of Bristol."
