## ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

### BUSINESS CORPORATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *James L. Anthony*  
*of the City of Cranston, County of Providence,*  
*State of Rhode Island, Thomas F.*  
*O'Honnell and William C. & Brand,*  
*both of Providence, in said County and State*  
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

*J. L. Anthony & Company*

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of

*manufacturing, buying and selling*  
*jewelers' findings and supplies of every*  
*kind and description, and chasing, designing,*  
*engraving, tool-making and engine turning.*

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *the City of Providence*

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be common stock in the amount of

*Six* thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of  
*One Hundred* dollars each.
