FOURTH. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is:

FIFTH. Provisions (if any) dealing with the preemptive right of shareholders pursuant to §7-1.1-24 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended:

To the extent permitted to be limited or denied in these Articles, no shareholder shall have any preemptive right to acquire any securities to be issued by the corporation.


EXHIBIT A

Article SIXTH: No director of the Corporation shall be liable to the Corporation or to its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of the director's duty as a director; provided, however, that this Article SIXTH shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director: (i) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or to its stockholders; (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; (iii) the liability imposed pursuant to the provisions of R.I.G.L. Section 7-1.1-43 (as in effect or as hereafter amended); or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit unless said transaction is permitted by R.I.G.L. Section 7-1.1-37.1 (as in effect or as hereafter amended). If the Rhode Island General Laws are amended after the adoption of this Article SIXTH to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of directors, then the liability of each director of the Corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Rhode Island General Laws, as so amended. Neither the amendment nor repeal of this Article SIXTH nor the adoption of any provision of these Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this Article SIXTH shall eliminate or reduce the effect of this Article SIXTH in respect of any matter occurring, or any cause of action, suit or claim that, but for this Article SIXTH, would occur or arise, prior to such amendment, repeal or adoption of an inconsistent provision.




