ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

(BUSINESS CORPORATION.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, the

*Walter A. Fuller, Frank L. Jackson,
John W. Mather, Walter A. Butts and
E. E. White,*

all of lawful age hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

W. A. Fuller and Son, Company

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of

*manufacturing, selling and otherwise
dealing in and disposing of jewelry and
jeweler's supplies and for the transaction of any
other business connected therewith, or incidental thereto.*

4th. Said corporation shall be located in

*the city of Pawtucket
in said State*

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be common stock in the amount of

one hundred thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of

one hundred dollars each.


