ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Edward Otis Stanley of East Orange, New Jersey, Charles Carney Mumford, Albert Knight Potter, Robert Wendell Taft, William Chace Greene, Byron Sprague Watson, Walter Lee Munro and Archibald Claflin Matteson, all of the City and County of Providence, all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2d. Said corporation shall be known by the name of ASSOCIATED ALUMNI OF BROWN UNIVERSITY.

3d. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of promoting a spirit of friendship and cooperation among the Alumni of Brown University and uniting the efforts of the Alumni and in other manners contributing to the furtherance and support of the interests of said institution.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the City and County of Providence and State of Rhode Island.

5th. The undersigned hereby waive notice of the first meeting of said corporation which meeting may be called by a

majority of the persons named in this agreement in such manner as they may determine, and such meeting shall be organized by the election of a temporary chairman and a temporary clerk.
