CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

JEWELERS SHIPPING ASSOCIATION

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Jewelers Shipping Association.

SECOND: Its principal office in the State of Delaware is located at No. 100 West Tenth Street in the City of Wilmington, County of New Castle. The name and address of its resident agent is The Corporation Trust Company, No. 100 West Tenth Street, Wilmington 99, Delaware.

<u>THIRD</u>: The objects or purposes to be promoted or carried on are:

any and all facilities, jewelry-type freight and such other freight as may be economically conjoined therewith in bulk or consolidated shipments to the end that such jewelry-type freight may be moved, transported and carried with the greatest degree of economy and efficiency to the members of the corporation; and to furnish the members of the corporation with advice, service and assistance in connection with the marketing, distribution, sale and delivery of their products in the markets of the world.

In furtherance of, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Delaware, and the objects and purposes herein set forth, it is expressly provided

that this corporation shall also have the following powers, viz:

Acting through its Board of Directors, its President and other officers, subject to the powers and restrictions of this Certificate of Incorporation, and its By-laws, to do all such acts as are necessary or convenient to the attainment of the objects and purposes herein set forth, and to the same extent and as fully as any natural person might or could do.

To purchase, lease, hold, sell, mortgage, and otherwise acquire and dispose of real or personal property; to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind with any person, firm, corporation and association; to do any acts necessary or expedient for carrying on any and all of the activities and pursuing any and all of the objects and purposes set forth in this Certificate of Incorporation and not forbidden by the laws of the State of Delaware.

To have offices and promote and carry on its objects and purposes within or without the State of Delaware, in other states, the District of Columbia, the territories or colonies of the United States and foreign countries.

To own and hold memberships in other associations formed under any laws of this state, or any other state, country, nation, or government, and while the holder thereof, to exercise all the rights of membership.

To make agreements of mutual aid or federation with other associations, other groups organized on a co-operative basis, and other nonprofit groups.

In general, to have all powers conferred upon a corporation by the laws of the State of Delaware, except as herein prohibited or forbidden by the By-laws of this corporation.

FOURTH: The corporation shall not have any capital stock. The conditions of membership shall be as follows, viz: The membership shall consist of persons, organizations and corporations who (1) are members in good standing of Manufacturing Jewelers and Silversmiths of America Inc., a Rhode Island corporation, (2) utilize the facilities of this corporation, (3) accept the published rules and regulations of this corporation, and (4) in the month of January of each year pay Ten Dollars annual dues to the corporation. The membership shall also consist of nonmembers of Manufacturing Jewclers and Silversmiths of America Inc. who fulfill the requirements set forth under (2), (3), and (4), above, and in addition are approved by the Membership Committee of the corporation appointed by the Board of Directors. Any member joining other than in the month of January shall be required to pay Ten Dollars dues at the time of joining as well as the Ten Dollars dues payable the next ensuing January.
