AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE ANTHONY LYCEUM LIBRARY
ASSOCIATION.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Lawton S. Johnson, Resolved Harvey, Asabel Matteson, Job Kenyon, Thomas A. Whitman, their associates, successors and assigns are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic under the name and style of the "Anthony Lyceum Library," to be located in Anthony village, Coventry, for the purpose of establishing, maintaining and keeping up a lyceum and library in said village, with power to hold real and personal estate of the value of ten thousand dollars, with all the rights and privileges, and be subjected to all the duties and liabilities, provided by chapter 125 of the revised statutes, and of the acts in addition thereto and in amendment thereof.
