The recreational, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, increasing without thinking the generality of the foregoing, the encouragement and fostering of community awareness in the history of the City of Warwick and the preservation and development of its historical areas, points of interest and artifacts.
2. The corporation may organize, operate and maintain building or buildings for the education, instruction and training of the members of the community for the purposes above enumerated. In addition, the corporation may engage in research, conduct studies, promote fellowship, collaborate, collate and exchange information with other organized public bodies, or governmental agencies. The corporation may acquire, display and distribute any and all nature, types and kinds of artifacts, art, literature and cultural objects and maintain and preserve any and all artifacts, buildings and other points or places of historical interest, value and worth.

FIFTH In no event shall any part of the net earnings or property of said
corporation inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members,
trustees, officers or directors or other private individuals, except that said
corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services
rendered. No substantial part of the activities of said corporation shall be the
carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation,
and said corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the
publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of
any candidate for public office.
SIXTH In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the
assets of said corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary or by operation of
law, its assets shall be distributed to such organization or organizations or-
ganized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, or edu-
cational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or
organizations under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the
corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law) as the Board
