JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 1951

AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 3 OF THE ACT, PASSED AT THE MAY SESSION, 1832, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS AS A SOCIETY, BY THE NAME OF THE ST. JAMES CHURCH, AT WOONSOCKET FALLS IN SMITHFIELD," THE NAME OF SAID CHURCH HAVING NOW BEEN CHANGED TO "SAINT JAMES' CHURCH AT WOONSOCKET."

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of the act, passed at the May session, 1832, entitled "An act to incorporate certain persons as a society, by the name of the St. James Church, at Woonsocket Falls in Smithfield," the name of said church having now been changed to "Saint James' Church at Woonsocket," by an act passed April 13, 1905, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 3. There shall be a meeting of said corporation on the first Monday of February in every year, at which meeting there shall be, and at any legal meeting, if necessary, there may be elected, not exceeding fifteen vestry men, and also a treasurer and secretary of the church, which last mentioned officer shall also be clerk of the vestry; and it shall be the duty of said vestry to elect from their number two wardens; and at all such meetings or either of them, any business connected with the affairs of said corporation may be transacted; seven members at least of the corporation shall be necessary to form a quorum, and meetings may at any time be called by giving three days' notice thereof from the pulpit of said church on some day of public worship, or by posting up notifications on the door of said church by direction of the minister and wardens for the time being, or by a majority of the vestry men, or by any twelve members of said corporation; provided, that if said corporation shall at any time fail of holding any of their annual

meetings, such failure shall not in any way impair or invalidate this act."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS AS A SOCIETY BY THE NAME OF THE ST. JAMES CHURCH AT WOONSOCKET FALLS, SMITHFIELD", PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ITS MAY SESSION, A. D. 1832, AND ALL ACTS IN AMENDMENT THEREOF AND IN ADDITION THERETO.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of an act entitled "An Act to Incorporate certain persons as a Society by the name of the St. James Church at Woonsocket Falls, Smithfield", passed by the General Assembly at its May Session, A. D. 1832, as amended, is hereby further amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 3.
