
**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED**

1. all of his acts, doings, and disbursements as Temporary and Permanent Receiver are approved, confirmed, and ratified;
2. that the Receiver's Recommendation on Allowance of Claims is approved;
3. that the administrative claims of the Receiver's Accountant, Thomas Vignali in the amount of \$4,252.45 for the preparation and filing of the 2017 tax returns, the administrative claim of the Receiver's Accountant, Thomas Vignali in the amount of \$5,000 for the preparation and filing of the 2018 tax returns and the Receiver in the amount of \$56,205.68 is awarded and allowed in full; and the Receiver is authorized and directed to pay such allowed administrative claims;
4. that the Receiver and the Receiver's accountant is discharged upon distribution of the aforescribed payments and filing of the 2018 tax returns was \$400 payment to the State of Rhode Island and the Receiver's bond is ordered cancelled;
5. that the Receiver is hereby authorized to abandon Respondent's books and records and any outstanding assets not assigned herein;


