To promote legislation favorable to the marine industry and to oppose any and all adverse legislation; 6. To promote marine facilities and to work with other organizations, such as the Coast Guard, Coast Guard Auxiliary, United States Power Squadrons in providing better and safer boating in Rhode Island waters; 7. To offer guidance, instructions and general assistance to the boat owner, particularly the newcomer; and 8. To do such lawful acts as may be deemed beneficial to those engaged in any phase of the boating business.

Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are: This Association is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of the Association shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director, or member (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to and for the Association). In the event of the liquidation of the Association, whether voluntary or involuntary, no officer, director, or member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of the Association, the balance of all money, assets and other property of the Association, after the payment of all its debts and obligation, shall, pursuant to a resolution of the Association or an order of a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Rhode Island be used by, or distributed to, an organization or organizations which would then qualify under Section 501(c) (6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and the regulations promulgated therein declinations will use such property to accomplish one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (6) of the internal Religious Code of 1954, as amended.
