## ARTICLE 4 (FOUR):

Section I: This corporation may dissolve or be dissolved as provided in Section 7-6-50 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island. Upon dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provisions for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of its assets exclusively for the purpose of the corporation, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes, as shall at the time, qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision or provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County of Prophose exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine are organized and operated exclusively for the purposes so stated.

Section II: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, or officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth on Article 3 (Three) hereof.

Section III: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Section IV: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted by a corporation exempt from the Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
