1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2d. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

3d. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of assisting in carrying out the provisions of the law providing for the certification of properly qualified persons as Certified Public Accountants; protecting the interests of its members, and promoting their welfare; encouraging the proper training of persons who desire to become Certified Public Accountants; promoting the study of law appertaining to accounts and securing the proper recognition of the practice of accountancy as a profession.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in Providence, R. I.,
