**ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST. The name of the corporation is  
ALLIED COURT REPORTERS, INC. *AK*

(A close corporation pursuant to §7-1.1-51 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended) (strike if inapplicable)

SECOND. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) perpetual

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (1) To conduct and engage in the business of stenography and court reporting; to furnish stenographic and court reporting services in connection with depositions, administrative hearings and court proceedings; to offer and provide computerized and other technological services and products in connection with same.
- (2) To engage in any other lawful business.

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FOURTH. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is:

- (a) *If only one class:* Total number of shares . 1000 shares, no par value common stock




