HEREBY CERTIFY, that at a legal meeting of said corporation, duly called for the purpose, and
held in the TOWN of FOSTER,
in said State, on the FIRST day of FEBRUARY, A. D. 1929,
the following amendment(s) to the Articles of Association (or Charter) was (or were) duly
adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of its
members, viz:—

"VOTED, That Article II read as follows:

SAID CORPORATION SHALL BE KNOWN BY THE NAME OF SOUTH FOSTER VOLUNTEER
FIRE DEPARTMENT NO. 1

Also voted that Article III read as follows:

SAID CORPORATION IS CONSTITUTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE PRESERVATION
AND PROTECTION OF PROPERTY FROM AND DURING SUCH FIRES AS MAY OCCUR
IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH FOSTER AND VICINITY

AN ACT

TO VACATE THE FORFEITURE OF THE
CHARTER OF SOUTH FOSTER VOLUNTEER
FIRE DEPARTMENT, NO. 1

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, the forfeiture of the charter of the SOUTH FOSTER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, NO. 1 incorporated at the January session, 1929, be vacated and said corporation shall thereupon be entitled to all of the privileges, benefits, and powers and subject to the same duties and liabilities as though no forfeiture of its charter had taken place.

The necessity of filing any and all reports and the payment of any fees hereunder or by any special or general law of this state is hereby relieved and excused.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and any acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Reports and fees will be due in future.
