In the event of liquidation, dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary or by operation of law, any remaining property or assets of the Corporation shall be distributed as the Board of Directors shall determine to such organization or organizations located in the State of Rhode Island as are defined in Sec. 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as the same may be from time to time amended.
