ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION (NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Bresents. That we LeRoy A. Straight, Jr., Donald
H. Potter, Donald R. Emery, Milton O. Graham, and Nathaniel C.
Peckham, all of the Town of South Kingstown, County of Washington,
State of Rhode Island
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:
FIRST. 4.: To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of
Rhode Island.
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of The Tower Hill Fire Company
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of training and
maintaining a volunteer fire department to assist in the suppression
of fires in the Town of South Kingstown and elsewhere and for assist-
ing in such other emergencies as may occur, and for the purpose of
extending to the people of South Kingstown and elsewhere the allied
services which a normal volunteer fire department performs.

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See §§ 7-6-7, 7-6-8 of the General Laws.)

To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have

⁽a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter:

⁽b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;

⁽c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;

⁽d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their

⁽c) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or atticles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government

⁽f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and horrow money.

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred lifty thousand dollars (\$150,000); provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to corporations organized for the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement or resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises within the state, and to whose members no profit shall enter. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or hy amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in South Kingstown, Rhode Island.
