ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we Herbert Morton Clarke, Henry
Greene Jackson, Benjamin Franklin Tefft, Jr., Courtland Cook Earle,
and Elisha Waterman Bucklin,

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other :

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode
Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of
The General Nathanael Greene Homestead Association.

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of perpetuating the
memory of General Nathanael Greene, and for other patriotic
purposes.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the town of Coventry, in the
State aforesaid.
