ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION  
(NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we ROBERT A. BUTLER, JOSEPH J. DAVIS,  
LOUIS LARGE, ARNOLD I. LANGLEY, ALBERT E. PROFFITT, JR., FRANK R.  
LONG and THOMAS Y. JACKSON, III

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended.

SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of MOUNT MORIAH  
TEMPLE ASS'N., INC.

THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of acquiring and  
holding title to real estate for the use and benefit of "Mount  
Moriah Lodge No. 8, F. & A. M. Lime Rock, Rhode Island," an unin-  
corporated association of the Town of Lincoln, State of Rhode Is-  
land, for fraternal meetings. In carrying out said purposes to  
acquire title to property, real or personal, by gift, purchase,  
bequest, or otherwise and to hold, use, improve, mortgage, pledge,  
sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the same, and to do and per-  
form anything incidental and necessary thereto.

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See §§ 7-6-7, 7-6-8 of the General Laws.)

To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power:

- (a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;
- (b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;
- (c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;
- (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;
- (e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of calling its names, and

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Lincoln, Rhode Island.  
(City or Town)

(Further provisions not inconsistent with law)

FIFTH All members of Mount Moriah Lodge No. 8, F. & A. M. Lime Rock, Rhode Island, an unincorporated association located in the Town of Lincoln, State of Rhode Island, whose names appear on the current membership list in good standing, and annually thereafter, shall be made members of this corporation, entitled to receive notice of meetings, with the privilege of voting.

SIXTH In the event of dissolution of the corporation, after the payment or satisfaction of all debts of the corporation, the remaining assets and funds of the corporation shall be conveyed or transferred to Mount Moriah Lodge No. 8, F. & A. M. Lime Rock, Rhode Island, a charitable corporation created under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, its successors and assigns; provided further, however, that no part of said assets or funds shall inure to the benefit of any member of the corporation and no fund or property of the corporation shall be distributed among or revert to any member, officer, or trustee of the corporation.
