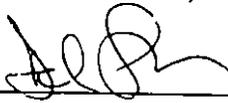

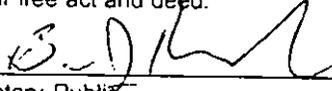

Continuation Sheet to Articles of Incorporation

Article 6:

Except as otherwise provided by statute, any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of shareholders may be taken without a meeting upon the written consent of less than all the shareholders entitled to vote thereon, if the shareholders who so consent would be entitled to cast at least the minimum number of votes which would be required to take such action at a meeting at which all shareholders entitled to vote are present. Prompt notice of such action shall be given to all shareholders who would have been entitled to vote upon the action if such meeting were held.
