ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Blackstone Valley Association for
Retarded Citizens Housing, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration (if perpetual, so state) Perpetual

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To provide elderly persons and handicapped persons with housing facilities and services specially designed to meet their physical, social and psychological needs, and to promote their health, security, happiness and usefulness in longer living, the charges for such facilities and services to be predicated upon the provision, maintenance and operation thereof on a non-profit basis.

FOURTH: Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are:

- (a) Regulation of Internal Affairs - see by-laws
- (b) Distribution of assets on dissolution or fiscal liquidation
1. In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation or the winding up of its affairs, or other liquidation of its assets, the Corporation's property shall not be conveyed to any organization created or operated for profit or to any individual for less than the fair market value of such property, and all assets remaining after the payment of the Corporation's debts shall be conveyed or distributed only to an organization or organizations created and operated for non-profit purposes similar to those of the Corporation other than one created for religious purposes: PROVIDED, however, that the Corporation shall at all times have the power to convey any or all of its property to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.


