Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-6-40 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation West Glocester Elementary School Volunteer Organization

2. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation:

The name of the corporation is hereby changed to: West Glocester Elementary School Community Organization
The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are hereby expanded to include the following objectives:

The West Glocester Elementary School Community Organization (the Organization) will develop and run programs to benefit the students of West Glocester Elementary School based on volunteer and community involvement. It is the objective of the Organization to give the community the opportunity for involvement with the school to make a profound effect on the children's education. Furthermore, it is the goal of the Organization to encourage students to become responsible members of their school and community at large and:

1. To develop among educators, parents and community volunteers such united efforts as will secure for every child the highest educational advantages in academic, emotional and social growth.
2. To enhance school-community relations.
3. To organize and fund educational, social arts and volunteer programs that inspires creativity in our students.

The Organization exists as a non-business, non-profit corporation.

Upon dissolution of this organization, the assets of the Organization, after all debts have been satisfied, shall be expended solely for the benefit of all students in West Glocester Elementary School.
