Pursuant to provisions of Section 7-6-40 Of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, the undersigned corporation, First Night Newport, Inc. adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

First Night Newport, Inc. is a non-profit corporation whose mission is to enhance the quality of life in Newport County by producing and promoting events and programs that celebrate family values, education, the arts, social entrepreneurship, and community. Our organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under section 501 © 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to becarried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 © 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 © 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
