ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, ^{James} NORMAN BRADLEY, CHARLES H. SHERWOOD, TIMOTHY RHODES, ANNA S. BRIGGS and LULIE A. JOHNSON, all of the Town of Johnston, County of Providence and State of Rhode Island, and of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

FIRST: To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

SECOND: Said corporation shall be known by the name of "GRANITEVILLE MEMORIAL ASSOCIATION".

THIRD: Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, establishing, erecting and maintaining memorials of monuments, tablets or of any character or nature whatsoever, commemorating the service of residents of the Village of Graniteville in the military and naval forces of the United States.

FOURTH: Said corporation shall be located in the Town of Johnston.
