HEREBY CERTIFY, that at a legal meeting of said corporation, duly called for the purpose,
and held in the city of Woonsocket
in said State, on the 2nd day of October, A. D. 1955,
the following amendment (s) to the Articles of Association was (or were) duly adopted by
the affirmative vote of all of its members viz:—
"VOTED, That Article Second be amended to read as follows:

Said corporation shall be known by
the name of Le Club Par-X Inc.

VOTED FURTHER, That Article Third be amended to read as follows:

Said corporation is constituted
for the following purposes:

- (a) To maintain building quarters and all its furnishings for its meetings or the meetings of the general assembly of its members or its subordinate bodies, and for the accommodation of other fraternal bodies or associations;
- (b) To apply, use, and distribute the entire net income of its real and personal property exclusively for the free education or relief of its members, and for the relief, support and care of worthy and indigent members, their wives, widows and orphans;
- (c) To cement bonds of fraternity and to promote favorable public relations for and amongst citizens of French descent in the United States;
- (d) To promote and encourage the Catholic, social, educational and economic endeavors of its members;
- (e) To assist in charitable, educational and civic organizations.
