ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *Matthew Harkins,*
Domenico Belliotti, Jeanne Coulter, Albina Rosaire,
Anna Lemieux, Adelaide Rassignana, Marie Goussé,
Antonio G. Capelli, Nicola Calzone —

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

Saint Raphael's Industrial Home and School

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of *aiding the poor generally* as an incorporated public charitable institution; especially by maintaining an industrial school for girls; by visiting sick persons deprived of proper care and giving them such attention as is needed, and instructing members of the household in the simple rules of hygiene; in founding and maintaining day nurseries for the care and instruction of poor children in the City of Providence.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *the City of Providence*

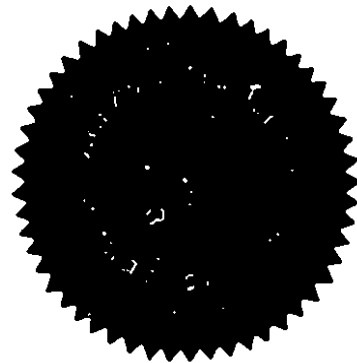
