GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 156B, SECTION 12

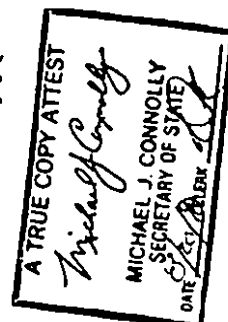
