THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To be a Church. To conduct regular worship services to include but not be limited to bringing people to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. To establish Bible schools, Christian education centers, and group homes for children and teens in a family setting until they are ready to go into foster homes. To be involved in Christian counseling. To establish a retirement home. To establish an outreadh ministry to include but not be limited to street ministry, nursing homes, prisons, and neighborhood centers. To provide for the needs of the poor via soup kitchens and to train the poor in health and nutrition, as well as providing temporary shelter for the poor.

FOURTH: Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for

the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are:

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, education, and scientific purposes and exclusively for such purposes including such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) which purposes shall include promoting the Word of God.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, officers, or other related persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and disbursements in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article third No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attemption to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Bederal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Codes of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
