1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of *buying, selling and manufacturing bottles and other ~~property~~

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *Providence, Rhode Island*
