ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

1. The name of the corporation is HOME - RITE INSPECTIONS, INC.



EXHIBIT "A"

SIXTH. For the regulation of the business and the conduct of the internal affairs of the corporation, it is further provided:

1. Shares of this corporation may be issued from time to time for such consideration consisting of cash, services, personal property, tangible and intangible, or real estate or such other consideration that shall be determined from time to time by the stockholders of this corporation.

2. No stockholder of this corporation shall make sale of any interests of said corporation held by him/her, without first giving written notice to the corporation of his/her intention to sell the same and giving to the stockholders of the corporation the right to purchase said interest at the lowest at which he/she is willing to sell before the same shall be sold by him/her to any other party. The corporation shall exercise the right to purchase the interest so offered to it within thirty (30) days of the receipt of said offer. If not accepted within said date, the stockholder shall be at liberty to make sale of said interest so offered to the corporation on the open market for a price of not less than one at which said is offered to the corporation.

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
