	FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation					
	under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of					
	Rhode Island, as amended.					
	SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

	THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of (a) To aid volunterly and to render assistance to all Farines and former Marines as well as to their widows and orphans; (b) to maintain true

	To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power:					
	 (a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter; 					
	(b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;					
	 (c) to have and use a common seal and after the same at pleasure; (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define 					

⁽e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;

(f) to make contracts, incur habilities and borrow money.

Said corporationshall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000), provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to certain corporations organized for the purposes enumerated in § 7-6-8. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Warway Town, Rhode Island.

(Further provisions not inconsistent with law)

FIFTH (a) shall, perpetual succession: (b) may charge and
collect dues for membership and receive contributions of money or
property to be devoted to carring out the purposes of the organiza-
tion; (c) May Losue of or be sued (d) may adopt a corporate seal
and alter it at pleasure (e) may establish and maintain offices for
