Knum all Men by these Bresents, That we Corrado Martellozzi, Flaminio

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:				
First. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation				
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Article III of Chapter 116 of the General				
Laws of Rhode Island.				
Second. Said corporation shall be known by the name of				
The Pious Society of the Missionaries of St. Charles Boromeo, Inc.				
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of arecting, building, or				
otherwise procuring a suitable building or buildings with sufficient land area				
and maintaining, equipping, managing and operating such as a home for the aid or				
support of the aged poor; and to generally do anything and everything necessary,				
expedient or incidental to the operation of a home for the aid or support of the				
aged poor in all its phases. The purpose of the organization of this corporation				
is for the general welfare and not for profit.

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See § 75, Chapter 116 of the General Laws.)				
To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power:				
(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;  (b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name:				
(c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;				
(d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;				
(e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the made of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;				
(f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.  Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not acceeding in all \$150,000.00. But if such corporation decires to take and hold property to an amount acceeding \$150,000.00 either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto.
