FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Article III of Chapter 116 of the General
Laws of Rhode Island.
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of
To promote the worship of God and to maintain public services for
teaching and preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ and to further
the interests of the Kingdom of God in the City of Providence, the
State of Rhode Island and throughout the world.
In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and
authority, viz:—(See § 75, Chapter 116 of the General Laws.)
To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limit- or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such cor-

(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;
(b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;
(c) to have and use a comon seal and alter the same at pleasure; (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;

(f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.

<sup>(</sup>e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all \$160,000.00. But if such corporation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding \$160,000.00 either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto. (Over)

## FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Providence, Rhode Island. (City or Town)
