ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *George B. Carpenter,*
Herbert F. Larkin, Horace L. Crandall,
Herbert C. Babcock, George E. Murphy, Frank Hill,
Daniel E. Blake, Paul M. Barber,

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2d. Said corporation shall be known by the name of *Ashaway Free*
Library.

3d. Said corporation is constituted for ~~the purpose of~~
literary, scientific, artistic and social
purposes and particularly for the purpose
of establishing and maintaining a free
library and reading room.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *the village of*
Ashaway in the town of Hopkinton, Rhode Island.

5th. The undersigned hereby waive notice of the first meeting of said corporation which meeting may be called by a majority of the persons named in this agreement in such manner as they may determine, and such meeting shall be organized by the election of a temporary chairman and a temporary clerk.
