It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The revocation of the charters of those business  
2 corporations enumerated in section 3 hereof, which are required  
3 by law to file annual reports with the secretary of state, shall  
4 be vacated. Said corporations shall be entitled to all the privi-  
5 leges, benefits, and powers, and shall be subject to all of the  
6 same duties and liabilities as though no revocation of their  
7 charters had taken place if, on or before December 31, 1986, said  
8 corporations shall (1) file any corporation tax returns as may be  
9 required; (2) pay all taxes which were due or should have been  
10 due to the state; (3) file with the secretary of state a certifi-  
11 cate signed by the tax administrator that such tax returns have  
12 been filed and such taxes have been paid; and (4) also file all  
13 reports and pay all fees which may be required by the secretary  
14 of state.
- 15 SECTION 2. The forfeiture or revocation of the charters of  
16 those non-business corporations enumerated in section 3 hereof,  
17 which are required by law to file biennial and/or annual reports

1 with the secretary of state, shall be vacated. Said corporations,  
2 subject to chapter 7-6, as amended, of the general laws, entitled  
3 the "Rhode Island non-profit corporation act" notwithstanding any  
4 provision of the law to the contrary, shall file all reports and  
5 pay all fees which may be required by the secretary of state, and  
6 shall also pay to the general treasurer for the use of the state  
7 such sum as the attorney general shall decide should be paid by  
8 said corporations, as a compromise of the penalty or penalties  
9 for such failure to file such reports.

10 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to the
