## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

(NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Bresents. That we Alfred J. Sousa, Joseph E. Raposa,
Edward P. Harrington, James E. Murphy, D.C., Henry V. Miller,
David J. Dunne, William V. O'Connell and Joseph Scanlon
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:
FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation Title 19, Chapter 21 under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 20 of the General Laws of
Rhode Island.
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of HOLY GHOST CREDIT UNION
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of operating a
credit union in the Town of Tiverton, R. I. in accordance with Title 19,
Chapter 21 - General Laws 1956.
In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and
authority, viz:—(See ***Cost ************************************
<ul> <li>(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;</li> <li>(b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>(c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure:</li> <li>(d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;</li> </ul>
(e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of bolding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;
(1) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.  Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000). But if such corporation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto.
