CERTIFICATE RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WOONSOCKET, RHODE ISLAND, AND THE DESIGNA-TION OF THE FIRST CHAIRMAN.

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of January ,1940, a public hearing was held in accordance with the applicable provisions of The Housing Authorities Law, Chapter 2255, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1935, for the purpose of allowing the residents and taxpayers of the City of Woonsocket, Rhode Island, and other interested persons to express to the Council their views on the necessity for a Municipal Housing Authority to function in the City; and

WHEREAS, immediately following the afore-mentioned public hearing, the Council of the City of Woonsocket, Rhode Island, met in special session and adopted the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY IN THE CITY OF WOONSOCKET. RHODE ISLAND.

WHEREAS, twenty-five residents of the City filed, in accordance with the authority vested in them by statute, a petition dated December 29, 1939, with the City Clerk, in which they set forth their opinion that there is need for a Housing Authority to function in this City; and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing duly held by the Council on this day a number of residents and taxpayers of the City, as well as other interested persons, indicated that in their opinion a Municipal Housing Authority should be established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOONSOCKET, RHODE ISLAND:

That the City Council of the City of Woonsocket, Rhode Island, after having given due consideration to the physical

conditions and the age of certain buildings in the City, the degree of overcrowding, the light and air available to the inhabitants of such dwelling accommodations, the size and arrangement of the rooms, the sanitary facilities and the extent to which conditions exist in such dwellings which endanger life or property by fire or other causes, hereby determines, finds and declares in pursuance of the provisions of the Housing Authorities Law of the State of Rhode Island:

- A. Unsanitary or unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in this City; and
- B. There is a lack of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in this City available for all inhabitants thereof.
- C. There is need for a Housing Authority in this City.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provision of said resolution, in pursuance of Sections 4 and 5, Chapter 2255, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1935, and by virtue of my office as Mayor:

I hereby appoint the five persons hereinafter named to serve as Commissioners of The Housing Authority of the City of Woonsocket Rhode Island, for the number of years appearing after their names respectively:

Hufus M. Laurum Five Years.

Jean M. Juesin Four Years.

Hun & Janthuy Three Years.

Addian M. Jenisum Two Years.

Addian M. Roges One Year.

The terms of office of the Commissioners shall begin as of the date of this Certificate. The Commissioners shall hold office until their successors have been appointed and have duly qualified.

I hereby designate Wilfred M. Gauvreau to serve as the first Chairman of The Housing Authority until his successor, elected from among the members of The Authority, shall have duly qualified.
