Roman Catholic Church or Congregation in the State of Rhode Island," passed January Session, 1869, and
an amendment thereof, January Session, 1872, and have become a body corporate under the name of
"Saint Mary's Church Corporation,
Carolina" and that the said Timothy L. Donovan
and Joseph E. Gallant have been duly selected by the ex-officio members of the
Corporation from the lay members of the above named Congregation, and that they have adopted the Acts
aforesaid as their Charter, and will be concluded and bound thereby.
