ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all men by these Presents, That we, Eleanor C. Moore, Emma C. Moore, George C. Moore, John V. Moore and Thomas F. Moore, all of the Town of Westerly, County of Washington and State of Rhode Island,

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1904 and all acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of George C. Moore Company.

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of manufacturing, selling and otherwise dealing in all varieties and kinds of textile fabrics, including webbing, cords, braids, etc., elastic and non-elastic, and including cotton, woolen, linen, silk, hemp and flax goods and all or any articles consisting in whole or in part of the above enumerated materials, and all combinations and products of the same, and all fabrics, textiles and materials now known or which may hereafter be known, found, discovered, devised, created or invented, grown, raised, produced or made; and of manufacturing, selling, and otherwise dealing in any machines and machinery for the purposes aforesaid, and acquiring and applying for and buying, selling and otherwise dealing in Letters Patent and Trade Marks of the United States or foreign countries covering any articles that this corporation is authorized to manufacture and sell, and doing all business collateral to any of the above enumerated purposes of this corporation.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the Town of Westerly, County of Washington and State of Rhode Island.

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be stock in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of one hundred (100) dollars each, all of which shall be common stock.
