ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

(Name of Corporation)

These Articles of Incorporation are signed by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation pursuant to the provisions of Act 327, Public Acts of 1931, as amended, and Act 284, Public Acts of 1972, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is N.A.I.C., Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

To aid in the preserving and strengthening of democratic capitalism by educating people in the investment principles that have been and are now being employed by members of the National Association of Investment Clubs;

To provide a center for the exchange of information and ideas between investment clubs;

To actively promote the formation of new investment clubs;

To provide investment advice and related services to any person; and

To engage in any lawful activity related to or in pursuit of any of the foregoing.
