ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all men by these Presents, That we Roswell B. Burchard and J. Webster Coombs, of Little Compton, in the County of Newport, and Frank A. Jackson, of Woonsocket, in the County of Providence, all in the State of Rhode Island, and Georgianna B. Withington, of Boston, and Marion O. Sherer, of Worcester, both in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

Little Compton Village Improvement Society.

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of promoting and encouraging social, literary, artistic and civic interests, activities and undertakings by and among its members, in the Town of Little Compton and by and among all residents and inhabitants of said Little Compton, for the welfare and prosperity of the community.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the town of Little Compton, County of Newport, State of Rhode Island.
