ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SWAROVSKI CONSUMER GOODS LIMITED

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-1.1-56 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is SWAROVSKI CONSUMER GOODS LIMITED.

2. The shareholders of the corporation (or, where no shares have been issued, the board of directors of the corporation) on February 8, 1999 in the manner prescribed by Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopted the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation:

Article SIXTH of the Articles of Association of the corporation is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"SIXTH: It is intended that any director or officer of the corporation have all the indemnification rights set forth in Rhode Island General Laws § 7-1.1-4.1, as amended, and the Corporation is authorized to take such action as it deems necessary to provide such indemnification."

3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 300; and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 300.
