## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

(NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION.)

Know all Men by these Bresents, That we Herbert Richard Cross,		
Henry G. Clark, Henry E. Dawson, John H. Wells and Hunter C. Whit

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:		
FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation		
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Article III of Chapter 248 of the General		
Laws of Rhode Island.		
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of		
C. "South County Art Association "		
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of		
promoting interest in Art and encouraging Artists in Washingto		
County, Rhode Island and supporting in everyway the aesthetic		
interests of the community, particularly by encouraging the		
production, exhibition and sale of works of art by local and		
other artists, by arranging lectures and discussions on art and		
by aiding in the preservation and deeper appreciation of the		
remains of local colonial art.		
In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and		
authority, viz:—(See Sec. 75, Chapter 248 of the General Laws.)  To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limit		
ing or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that said corporation shal bave power:		
<ul> <li>(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name, unless a period for its duration is limited in these articles of association;</li> <li>(b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>(c) to have and use a common seal, and alter the same at pleasure;</li> <li>(d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define</li> </ul>		
their duties; (a) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with these articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions whether of the amme or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;		

<sup>(</sup>f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred-fifty thousand dollars. But if it desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto. (OVER)

## FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in South Kingstown. Rhode Island. (City or/Town)
