



ATTACHMENT TO DUPLICATE ARTICLES FOR  
THERAPEUTIC IMPRESSIONS, LLC

Item No. 6 is as follows:

A Manager of a Limited Liability Company shall not be personally liable to the Limited Liability Company, or to its members, for monetary damages for breach of any duty provided for in Section 17 of the Rhode Island Limited Liability Company Act, as may hereafter be amended (the "Act"), except for (i) liability for breach of the manager's duty of loyalty to the Limited Liability Company or its members, (ii) liability for act or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (iii) liability imposed pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of the Act, or (iv) liability for any transaction from which the manager derived an improper personal benefit, unless said transaction was with the informed consent of the members or a major majority of the disinterested managers.
