ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2d. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

3d. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of *honoring*
and preserving the memory of Roger
Williams, the preparation and preservation
of an authentic genealogy of his descendants
