ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 10: In the event of termination, dissolution or winding up of this Corporation in any manner or for any reasons whatsoever, its remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to (and only to) one or more organizations existing solely for educational and/or charitable purposes and qualifying under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue law).
