ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we John H. Fleming,  
William M. Greene, Orlando B. Jones, Edward S.  
Peterson, William Winston and Archie Marshall

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2d. Said corporation shall be known by the name of the Congdon  
Street Baptist Church

3d. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of promoting the  
cause of the christian religion and to carry on  
the work of Almighty God in accordance with  
Baptist principles.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the City of Providence

5th. The undersigned hereby waive notice of the first meeting of said corporation which meeting may be called by a majority of the persons named in this agreement in such manner as they may determine, and such meeting shall be organized by the election of a temporary chairman and a temporary clerk.
