HEREBY CERTIFY, that at a legal meeting of said corporation, duly called for the purpose,

and held in the City of Newport, Rhode Island

in said State, on the 5th day of February, A. D. 1982,

the following amendment(s) to the Articles of Association was (or were) duly adopted by the affirmative vote of Two Thirds of its members viz:—

"VOTED, That Said Corporation shall be known by the name of The Martin Luther King Community Center, Incorporated.

That: Said Corporation is constituted for the purpose of:

- (1) Conducting and promoting meaningful community services for the socio-economic and psychologically disadvantaged members of Newport County, Rhode Island.
- (2) Planning, developing, and organizing supportive program services to enhance an individuals personal growth and development, and to assist him/her to reach the highest human potential through academic, vocational, and experiential learning modalities.
- (3) Acting as an advocate for social change, and providing a network of social services in recreation, education, special services, child development, black history, criminal justice, alcoholism, drug addiction, employment opportunities, and economic development, and to provide whatever services necessary, to strengthen the well being of the community, as a whole.
